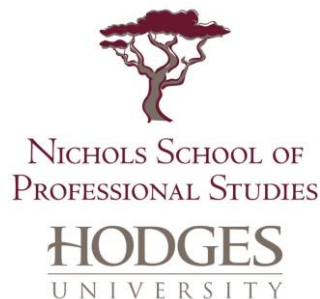


## Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies (120 Credit Hours) 2018 – 2019 Program Curriculum Guide

<b>Area III: Elective Component</b>			
Credit for courses taken under the Elective Component may be granted through either advanced standing credit (transfer credits) or classes taken at Hodges University as approved in consultation with the student success advisor. The number of credits for the elective component is determined by the area of focus. As an alternative to electives, students may also declare a certificate program, i.e. certificate in professional sales. The certificate program must be declared as a secondary program and is fulfilled by taking 15-16 semester hour credits as part of the elective requirement. Total elective component of 3-45 depends on the designated area of focus, either in the General Interdisciplinary Studies or Digital Design and Graphics.

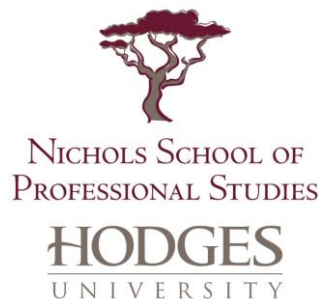
